From the Pastor...

Once each year Christians attend a church service which lasts about a dayand-a-half. When going to church on Good Friday, all the worshipers leave without receiving the benediction. There is no hand-shaking either, but that act of fellowship does not conclude the service; the benediction does. And so without the benediction, the service is not over...not until the benediction is given the following Sunday at the conclusion of the Easter service.

This is not an over-sight--leaving off the benediction at the Good Friday service. It is very intentional. Good Friday never stands by itself. There can be no Good Friday without Easter, just as there can be no Easter without Good Friday. The two belong together. Jesus' death is without meaning unless Easter takes place. And because He did rise on

the third day, Good Friday now finds its conclusion in the Easter event.

This sets the pattern for our life in Christ. Just as Good Friday and Easter are inseparable, so is Confession and Absolution. Confession is meaningless unless Absolution is given. Judas confessed his sin of betrayal to the priests, but they gave him no forgiveness and so he perished in unbelief. Jesus commands His pastors to absolve the sins of those who repent. Absolution must follow confession just as Easter must follow Good Friday. On the other hand, there can be no absolution unless one repents. Jesus forbids His pastors from absolving the sins of those who refuse to repent. Just as there can be no Easter without Good Friday, so there can be no absolution without confes-

Good Friday and Easter also sets the pattern for our life to come. We who trust in our Lord Jesus, who confess our sins and believe in the word of Absolution spoken to us by our pastor--we do not fear when death comes to us or to our loved ones, because we know that Easter must follow Good Friday. The burial at the gravesite is not the conclusion. The final benediction will not take place until the Resurrection. Because Jesus, who died, also rose again, so we who live and die in Christ must also rise again when He calls us forth from our graves. There is no cause for doubt here. It is absolutely certain. Easter always follows Good Friday. It did for Jesus. It does for us who live in His forgiveness. It will for us who fall asleep in Jesus.


