From the Pastor ...

There were fifteen of us, all Lutheran pastors, gathered together in a remote sanctuary outside of Springfield, Illinois. Our teachers were the Rev. Dr. Harold Senkbeil and Dr. Beverly Yahnke, two of the very best. Rev. Tyler Arnold was our chaplain, and Matthew Machemer, from the Ft. Wayne seminary, was our cantor. We were together for three days, and we entered the church for worship nine times. Worship is central to our life and growth as Christians. We ate well, we had "Lutheran fellowship" at night, but best of all, we gained insights -- insights like I had never gained before. I found myself wishing (as we all did) that this wonderful teaching would have been given to me while at the seminary. This was *Doxology: The Gathering*.

What did I gain? It's impossible to put down in a few words the wisdom that was imparted in these few days, but I will try to summarize it here for you. I learned about the care of souls -- your souls. I learned about self-care. I learned about being a sheepdog (more on that at a later date). I learned about the ways in which the devil attacks the sheep, and how to protect the sheep from such attacks. I learned about the ways in which the devil attacks your pastor, and how to parry his attacks.

Doxology: The Gathering is only the beginning. *Doxology: The Encore* follows, and then comes *Doxology: The Reunion. The Reunion* is for pastors and their wives. It will be held in Texas next Summer. *The Encore* is for the pastor and his congregational members. It will be back in Springfield the first weekend of November 2015. **Any member who wants to attend can go**. This is important because it provides a vehicle for God to bring our members together. Our church has already paid for one layperson to go, but more can make the request to attend. Most congregations send multiple laypeople. And it is ongoing. Every year, *The Encore* is open to any laypeople from those congregations who have sent their pastors to *The Gathering*. The more members who attend *The Encore* this year, and in upcoming years, the more blessed we will be as a congregation.*

To conclude, thank you so very much for allowing me the privilege of attending. I am truly blessed by God to be the pastor, the sheepdog, here at Christ Lutheran Church. Not only do I pray for each and every one of you by name regularly; I thank God for each one of you. I can truly say that I have real joy in my ministry here among you.


