From the Pastor...

"In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Luke 13:28

On the Last Day there will be tears and wailing like never before, and there will be anger and rage so intense that people will gnash their teeth. These are the ones who will be standing outside the door of heaven. They will be


angry at Jesus, true; but they will also be full of anger toward others: their priest or pastor who led them astray from the truth by not rightly dividing Law and Gospel; their family members who refused to warn them that they were neglecting their salvation; their friends and neighbors who were afraid to speak to them about Jesus.

Too many Christians are not willing to con-

front their friends and loved ones about the most important topic of all: their soul's salvation. They are afraid of losing a friend, perhaps, or of turning a family member against them. Better, however, to have someone angry at us for a while here on earth, than to have them angry at us forever. "*Am I my brother's keeper?*" Cain replied to God. Yes, we are. "*To whom much is given, much is expected.*" We who have the Gospel of Christ; who have been given the assurance of our salvation through Him who died for us and for all sinners, how can we keep this to ourselves? If we lose a friend, so be it. A real friend would care about my most pressing need and speak to me about it. If we upset a loved one, thank God! How much worse if there was apathy instead of anger. The anger is being caused by the Law at work within them.

When Esther was afraid to speak to the king about Haman's plan to destroy her fellow Jews, her uncle, Mordecai, said these words of wisdom to her: *"Who knows whether you have not come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"* The same can be said of us. Who knows whether God has not placed us next to our friend, neighbor, or loved one for the distinct privilege of being used by the Holy Spirit to bring them to Christ, or to bring them back to Christ? God will bless whenever we speak to another about their salvation in Christ. *"Your labor, in the Lord, is not in vain"* (1 Corinthians 15:58). God's Word will not return to Him empty, but will accomplish that which He purposes (Isaiah 55:11). Let us not live in fear of losing friends and loved ones; let us, rather, pray that God opens the door of heaven to those He puts before us as He speaks the word of salvation through us.


