From the Pastor...

Many people have a "Santa Claus" understanding of God. You know the song: "he's gonna find out who's naughty and nice..." Nice people go to heaven; the naughty ones don't. And Jesus' own words in Matthew 25 seem to agree. The sheep are the nice ones and the goats are the naughty ones. The sheep, according to Jesus, did nice things during their life; the goats failed to do such niceties.

This "Santa Claus" understanding of God is quite revealing. If this is someone's religion, what need do they have of Baptism, the Word, the Sacra-

ment? They would have no need of the church or a pastor. In other words, they have no need of Jesus. Just be nice. The rewards come, even the reward of heaven, to all who are nice.

"It's not about being naughty or nice. It's about Jesus. Heaven is yours not if you are nice, but because of Jesus and what He did, and does, for you."

There is a flaw with this belief system,

and it's fatal. When mom and dad tell their children to behave if they want Santa to bring them presents at Christmas, the children comply by being nice and not naughty. This is not true of Jesus' sheep. In Matthew 25 He tells us that the sheep aren't even aware of the nice things they did during their life on earth. They weren't nice in order to gain rewards. They lived as they did because they are sheep. Yet the sheep are as naughty as the goats. And there are goats who, in the world's eyes, are much nicer than sheep. The difference between them is Jesus. The sheep love Jesus; the goats do not. The sheep show their love for Jesus; the goats cannot. The sheep trust Jesus and desire Him; the goats do not. Jesus declares all forgiven: sheep and goats. He died for all sinners. The sheep take Jesus' word to heart, cling to it, and live it; the goats do not.

It's not about being naughty or nice. It's about Jesus. Heaven is yours not if you are nice, but because of Jesus and what He did, and does, for you. When you're nice to others, it's Jesus doing this through you. Santa may not set aside any presents for those who are naughty, but Jesus forgives the naughty, and He gives this gift of Absolution to the undeserving. You and I don't have to live in a certain way to gain the reward of heaven. Rather, we want to be nice because heaven is already ours through Jesus.


